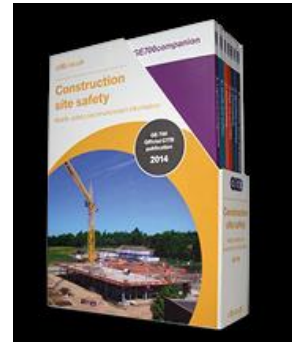


Site Management Safety Training Scheme (SMSTS) REFRESHER for the Construction and Civil Engineering Industries



Site Management Safety Training Scheme REFRESHER (SMSTS-R)

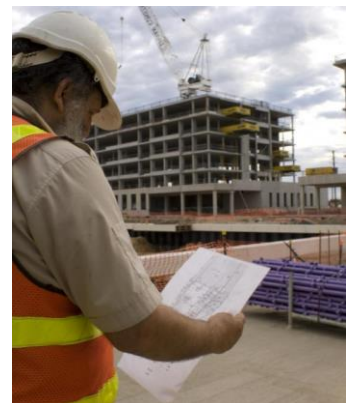
This two-day course aims to refresh understanding of key responsibilities and accountability for site safety, health, welfare and the environment, to enable delegates to provide healthy and safe working conditions for everyone on site.

The SMSTS Refresher is a highly interactive course, involving case studies, classroom discussion, group work and individual/group presentations.

Course Programme

The Site Management Safety Training Scheme Refresher course includes:

- Overview of changes to the current legislation affecting construction
- The current focus of the HSE's attention
- Risk assessment and method statements
- CDM Regulations
- Reporting of Injuries, Diseases and Dangerous Occurrences (RIDDOR)
- Behavioural safety
- Occupational health
- Work at Height
- Control of Substances Hazardous to Health (COSHH)
- Noise and Vibration at Work
- Fire on construction sites
- Toolbox Talks



Entry requirements

The delegate must have a current SMSTS certificate at the time of this course. The refresher course must be completed before the five year expiry date on the previous course certificate.

The minimum entry requirement is a good understanding of spoken and written English.

This is an interactive course delivered by means of case studies, classroom discussion, group work and individual/group participation. Candidates will be continuously assessed throughout the course and will have to successfully complete a multiple-choice / basic written answer test.

The course cost for each delegate includes - CITB publication Construction Site Safety (GE700), registration/certificate, lunch and light refreshments.

This qualification must be renewed every five years by attending the SMSTS Refresher course (2 day).

In-scope employers who provide their CITB Levy number will receive an automated grant per delegate on successful completion.
